TOWNSEND: Bruce N. Beauchesne, 82, of Townsend, formerly of Lexington, died unexpectedly Monday, December 27, 2021 at University of Massachusetts – Memorial Hospital, Worcester.

Mr. Beauchesne was born in Newton, July 8, 1939 the son of Joseph Beauchesne and Evelyn (Jones) Beauchesne Burnell and grew up in Lexington. He was a 1957 graduate of Lexington High School and later continued his education at Northeastern University, Boston.

For four years he served his country in the United States Air Force.

For thirty three years Mr. Beauchesne owned and operated with his wife June, Laser Services Inc. in Westford, a company specializing in precision laser machining, drilling, welding and engraving of a wide variety of materials. In 2007 they transitioned into their retirement when they successfully sold their business to a firm now known as Accumet Engineering Inc.

Since moving to Townsend twenty six years ago, Mr. Beauchesne became active in the community in many ways including serving on the Townsend Finance Committee, the Townsend Library Endowment Committee, was a member and past president of the Townsend Couples Club and was a member of the Townsend Congregational Church.

He enjoyed reading, hiking, fishing, canoeing, camping and spending time at the family homestead located in the Adirondacks in Keeseville, New York. When he resided in Lexington he was active in the Boy Scout program there.

He leaves his wife of 61 years, June (Preston) Beauchesne; two sons, Barry P.

Beauchesne of Townsend, Alan B. Beauchesne of Bolton; three daughters, Christine B. Doherty and Holly L. Beauchesne both of Townsend, Suzanne E. Boudrot of Littleton; a sister, Joyce Gray of Litchfield, NH; fifteen grandchildren and four great grandchildren with a 5th on the way.

Funeral services will be held 11 AM Saturday, April 2, 2022 at Townsend Congregational Church, Brookline Street, Townsend.
