Gloria T. (Roy) Boudreau, 94, of Fitchburg, died Monday, October 29, 2018 at her home surrounded by her loving family.

Her husband, Louis G. Boudreau, died in 1984.

Mrs. Boudreau was born in Fitchburg, April 6, 1924, a daughter of the late Joseph and Regina (Masse) Roy and was a lifelong Fitchburg resident.

Mrs. Boudreau worked for several years as a machine operator at the former Berkey Photo in Fitchburg. Prior to that she was employed at Fitchburg Yarn, Independent Lock and Alcon Plastics. She attended St. Joseph's Church and Sacred Heart Church. She was a lifetime member of the British American Cub in West Fitchburg.

She leaves a son, Brian Boudreau of Fitchburg; three daughters, Evelyn Coleman and Lois Boudreau both of Fitchburg, and Noreen English of Berkley; 16 grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren, a great-great grandson and several nephews and nieces.

She was predeceased by five sons, William Boudreau of Fitchburg in 1952, Wayne Boudreau of Fitchburg in 1975, Gerard "Sonny" Boudreau of Fitchburg in 1996, Paul Boudreau of Westminster in March of this year, and Dennis L. Boudreau of Fitchburg in September of this year. She was also the last of eleven children, having been predeceased by eight brothers and two sisters

Her funeral Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, November 3, at 10 AM in St. Joseph's Church, 49 Woodland Street, Fitchburg. Burial will be in St. Josephs Cemetery.
