Kathy leaves behind her high school sweetheart and loving husband of 38 years James Araujo, her daughter Heather Araujo of Nashua, NH, her son Dillon Araujo of Pepperell, MA and her two Shih Tzus Molly and Bella, as well as her brother John Creighton and his wife Lily of Rockledge, FL and her nephew Michael Creighton of Portland, OR.
