AYER: Laura J. (Jordan) Callahan, 69, of Ayer, formerly of Quincy, died Monday, October 18, 2021 at her residence after a year-long battle with pancreatic cancer.

Laura was born in Quincy, August 25, 1952, a daughter of Barbara (Benson) Jordan and the late Robert and grew up in Quincy. She was a graduate of North Quincy High School and continued her education at Northeastern University.

Laura worked for the Town of Ayer School Department for over 24 years retiring in 2015 as the Executive Assistant to the Superintendent of Ayer Public Schools.
