Upon completion of high school Richard enlisted in the U.S. Army. During his 24 year service career he served in Korea, Viet Nam and many other post both overseas and stateside. After retiring as a Master Sergeant from the Army in 1983 he worked for The Department of the Army as a civilian GS11 assigned to Fort Devens, MA and Fort Huachuca, AZ until 1993.
