AYER: Theodore A. "Teddy" Januskiewicz, Jr., 68, of Ayer died Saturday, February 27, 2021 at Sterling Health Care Center, Sterling after a lengthy illness.

Teddy was born in Shirley, February 16, 1953, a son of Ann F. (Phillips) Januskiewicz and the late Theodore A. Januskiewicz, Sr. and was a lifelong Ayer resident. He was a 1970 graduate of Ayer High School and continued his education at Mount Wachusett Community College in Gardner.

Teddy worked many years in the maintenance department at Ayer Junior/Senior High School and drove bus for the Januskiewicz Bus Co. He was active in the Ayer community, Teddy served on the Ayer Fire Department, Ayer Park Department, Nashoba Valley Technical High School Committee, Ayer Animal Control Officer as well as being active in the Ayer Boy Scout Troop 3. He attended St. Mary's Church in Ayer.

Teddy was known to many as a "Mr. Fix It" and would often be found working in his garage. A skilled mechanic, Teddy always loved tinkering on cars. He was a go-to for townies to have their cars fixed, and in his later years he enjoyed refurbishing his 1956 Chevrolet. He spent countless hours working on projects with his children. He was our mentor and hero in our lives. He also enjoyed spending time in any activity that his grandchildren were involved in from playing in the yard, to watching them play sports, to helping to build pinewood derby cars. He was there in every part of their lives. His life lessons and memories that he taught in "Grampy School" will live on for many years to come with his children and grandchildren.
