July 13, 1972 - November 10, 2022

SHIRLEY: Aaron J. "Snake" Baird, 50, of Shirley, formerly of Cape Cod, died unexpectedly Thursday, November 10, 2022 at his home following a recent struggle with cancer.

Aaron was born in Cambridge, July 13, 1972, a son of Thomas L. and Correen N. (LaBuff) Baird and has resided in Shirley for the past twenty years. He was a 1990 graduate of Cape Cod Technical School in Harwich and continued his education at Peterson Electrical School in Woburn.

In addition to his parents of Suffolk, VA he leaves his sister, Natasha Baird of Portsmouth, VA, his paternal grandmother Nadyne (Johnston) Ryder as well as his Piccolino family and especially his longtime and dear friend, Tim Bresnahan.

He was predeceased by his grandparents Gordon D. & Mary E. "Bessie" (Joyce) Tuttle of Cambridge.

For the past 20 years Aaron worked as the manager of the Piccolino Bar & Grille in Shirley. Prior to that he worked at the former Johnny D's in Somerville, Sofies Bar & Grill & Goodfellas both in Hyannis and Trader Ed's at Hyannis Marina.

Aaron was an accomplished guitar player and singer. He had played and was lead vocalist at the Piccolino Bar & Grille for several years in the group known as "Lost" and was well known in the Cape Cod area as "Snake & the Fatman".

Aaron's family will receive relatives and friends at calling hours 2-4 PM Sunday, November 20, 2022 at the Anderson Funeral Home, 25 Fitchburg Road (Rte. 2A) Ayer. A time of sharing and reflection will begin at 3:15 PM.
