Mr. Salerno was born in Fitchburg, December 9, 1932, a son of Antonio and Marion (Salerno) Salerno.

He leaves his wife of 62 years, Jeannette D. (LeBlanc) Salerno; a son, Anthony Salerno III and his wife, Viola, of Fitchburg; a daughter, Linda M. Forand and her husband, David of Gardner; five grandchildren, two great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

He was the brother of the late Joseph Salerno of Florida, Anna Greene and Marco Salerno both of Fitchburg, Philomena Richard of Arizona.

During the Korean Conflict, Mr. Salerno served his country in the United States Army. For over 35 years, he worked at Foster Grant Company in Leominster before retiring in 1994.
