



## Anthony F. Tessi

June 15, 1937 - November 10, 2024

Fitchburg – Anthony F. Tessi, 87, a lifelong resident of Fitchburg, passed away peacefully on Sunday morning, November 10, 2024.

Born on June 15, 1937, in Fitchburg, Tony was the son of the late Frank and Antonia (Longo) Tusia. Tony was predeceased by his seven siblings.

He was a 1955 graduate of Fitchburg High School and later earned his Associate's Degree at Worcester Junior College.

Tony was a prominent figure in the local business community. He co-founded Montachusett Construction Company Inc. and served as its President for many years. He was also a real estate broker and owned and operated Silver Crest Realty Inc. Tony's professional contributions extended beyond his businesses. He served as a past Trustee for the Painters Health and Welfare Fund and the Painters Pension Fund, as well as Secretary for the Painters Industry and Betterment Fund. Additionally, he was a Trustee of the Carpenters Joint Apprentice Committee and held the position of President and former member of the International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans. Tony also contributed to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Construction Supervisor License Board and served as Vice Chairman for the Fitchburg Industrial Finance Committee, which helped to foster the growth and development of local businesses.

A dedicated community member, Tony was an active participant in local organizations. He was a past President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary of the Fitchburg East Rotary Club and a long-time member of the Fitchburg Lodge of Elks #847. Tony was a lifetime member of Saint Anthony di Padua Church, where he served on the finance committee for many years. He was also a notary public and proudly served in the Massachusetts National Guard from 1957 to 1965.

Tony is survived by his beloved wife of 64 years, Constance M. (DiConza) Tessi of Fitchburg; two daughters, Mary-Elizabeth Maynard and her husband, Kevin, and Ann-Margaret Tessi-Mitchell and her husband, Jeffrey, all of Fitchburg; and four grandsons whom he cherished deeply, Kevin A. Maynard, Nicholas J. Maynard, Anthony J. Mitchell, and Massimo J. Mitchell.

Known for his kind and gentle nature, Tony had a sharp wit and an unparalleled knowledge of the construction industry. His greatest joy, however, was his family. After his retirement, he dedicated himself to being an integral part of his grandsons' lives, relishing the time spent with them. Tony was a man of great faith which he exemplified throughout his life always putting the needs of others first.

Tony will be deeply missed by all who knew him, but his legacy of service, love for family, and commitment to his community will live on in the hearts of all those he touched throughout his lifetime.
