



## Archie A. Rouleau Jr.

April 24, 1931 - August 29, 2023

FITCHBURG – Archie A. “Bob” Rouleau, Jr., 92, passed away peacefully on August 29, 2023 in Leominster Crossing surrounded by his family.

Archie was born in Cambridge on April 24, 1931, a son of the late Archie A. and Claire (Bolduc) Rouleau. After graduating from Fitchburg High School, he enlisted in the US Army, where he proudly served his country during the Korean War until his honorable discharge in 1954.

Upon returning home Archie became a licensed electrician and over time earned, a master electrician license. He spent his 40-year career working as such for the Weyerhaeuser and Crocker Paper Mills and retiring from General Electric.

Archie was a life-long banjo enthusiast who played with a few local groups and in his later years played with the “Fine Tuners” that brought old-time songs to retirement homes across the region. He was kind, had a quick wit, was proud of his French-Canadian heritage and could fix anything in his basement laboratory.

He is survived by his two daughters, Denise Rouleau of West Dennis, Kathleen Rouleau and husband Derek Fairchild of Lunenburg; grandchildren, Lauren Benchoff, Delaney Benchoff, Sydney Arnold; step grandchildren, Ian, Nikia, and Casey Fairchild; several nieces and nephews.

Archie was predeceased by his wife of 64 years, Jeannine (LaPierre) Rouleau, and two brothers, Andre and Paul Rouleau.
