LUNENBURG: Betty Ann (Andzenas) Zanghi, 83, of Lunenburg, formerly of Leominster died Monday, March 3, 2025 at the Jewish Healthcare Center, Worcester.

Her husband of 59 years, Frank J. Zanghi, Sr. died in August 2020.

Betty Ann was born in Fitchburg, August 7, 1941, a daughter of John and Elizabeth (White) Andzenas and resided many years in Leominster before moving to Lunenburg ten years ago.

She was a 1959 graduate of Fitchburg High School and continued her education at Fitchburg State College where she received both her Bachelors and Masters Degrees in Elementary Education.

Betty Ann taught the majority of her 38 year teaching career at Reingold Elementary School in Fitchburg, retiring in 2001.

Betty Ann was a member of St. Anna's Church in Leominster where she taught CCD classes for many years. When she moved to Lunenburg, she joined Our Lady of the Lake Church in Leominster, where she was an active member of the Church and a member of The Women's Guild.
