STERLING: Beverly A. (Pelletier) St.Cyr, 77, of Sterling, formerly of Leominster and Louisville, Kentucky, died unexpectedly at home on Monday, April 19, 2021.

Beverly was born in Leominster, November 24, 1943, the daughter of Leo and Pearine (Salvatelli) Pelletier and resided in Sterling for 32 years. She was a 1961 graduate of Leominster High School and continued her education at Fitchburg State University. For many years Beverly worked at Merle Norman Cosmetics in Leominster and found great joy in bringing out the beauty in others.

Beverly was a devout Christian and her strong faith helped her to carry on with grace and dignity throughout her 27-year-long struggle with Parkinson's disease.

Beverly had impeccable taste and flair and it showed in everything she did from interior design to the stylish outfits she wore. She enjoyed spending time with her family and friends, attending church and Bible study, learning more about interior design and art, spoiling her precious dogs, and shopping at T.J. Maxx.

Beverly leaves behind her husband of nearly 57 years, Henry P. St.Cyr and

two daughters Suzanne M. St.Cyr and Jennifer A. St.Cyr both of Leominster. She also leaves her sister Susan M. Broderick (Lawrence) of Westminster, and two sisters-in-law Mary Ann Brockelman (Michael) of Holden, and Jane Pelletier of Leominster as well as many beloved nieces and nephews. In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her brother Richard L. Pelletier of Leominster and her brother-in-law Edward T. Rockwell Sr. and sister-in-law, Sheila (St.Cyr) Rockwell of Leominster.
