Born in Fitchburg, December 11, 1929 to John G. and Alice C. (Honeyfield) Maggs; she married Willard L. Johnson in 1954. They were happily married until he passed in 1999. Beverly was predeceased by her son, John Johnson and his wife, Heidi, of New Ipswich, NH.
