FITCHBURG / TEMPLETON - Camille J. Goguen, 74 of Fitchburg and Templeton, passed away at his home, surrounded by his family on Sunday, June 19, 2022.

Born in Moncton, raised in Port Elgin New Brunswick, Canada on April 23, 1948, Camille was one of ten siblings born to the late Alphee and Delia (Richard) Goguen. He moved to Fitchburg Massachusetts when he was 13. He graduated from St. Bernard's Central Catholic high school and proudly served the United States Army; serving overseas during the Vietnam War. After his honorable discharge, Camille worked as a Welder at Simonds Saw in Fitchburg for 42 years. Camille will always be remembered as a man of deep faith, a devoted husband and father who was passionate for antique cars.

In addition to his parents, Camille was predeceased by his sisters, Theresa Vautour, and Sr. Marie Rose Goguen; his brothers, Charles Goguen, Ovila Goguen, Leo Goguen, Laurie Goguen and Valmont Goguen.

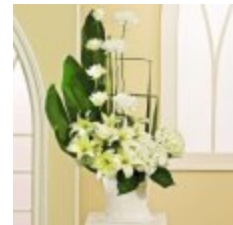
