ASHBY: Carol J. (Hill) Mickola, 72, a longtime resident of Ashby, died Thursday, November 15, 2018 at Bay State Medical Center, Springfield.

Mrs. Mickola was born in Fitchburg, November 29, 1945, a daughter of Joan R. (Bailey) Hill and the late Walfred E.A. Hill and resided most of her life in Ashby.

She was a graduate of Ashby High School and Fitchburg State College. For over 30 years Mrs. Mickola taught at Spaulding Memorial School and Squanacook Elementary Schools both in Townsend, retiring in 2003.
