ASHBY: Caryl M. (Moore) Leeds, 63, of Ashby, formerly of Bedford, died unexpectedly Tuesday, June 9, 2020.

Caryl was born in Medford, October 31, 1956, one of three children born to Francis J. and Helen A. (Greenleaf) Moore. She grew up in Bedford and was a 1974 graduate of Bedford High School. She continued her education at Middlesex Community College and then later at Cape Cod Community College.
