



## Charles R. Huse

December 28, 1949 - February 26, 2023

Charles R. Huse, 73, devoted husband, father, grandfather, uncle, and friend, died at home on Sunday, February 26, 2023. He had recently been diagnosed with ALS.

Born and raised in Fitchburg to Russell and Adele (Matson) Huse on December 28, 1949, he graduated from Fitchburg High School in 1967 and then went on to UMass Amherst, graduating in 1971.

Charlie was a rural letter carrier for the United States Postal Service in Townsend for 37 years before retiring in 2011. He was an active member of the Finnish Center of Saima Park and served on the Board of Directors for a number of years.

During the summer, Charlie could often be found at the family camp on Lake Shirley in Lunenburg. He loved travelling and made trips to France, Finland, and Ireland. A hiking trip in the Grand Canyon with two of his brothers-in-law was a post-retirement highlight.

Charlie leaves his wife, Joanne (Kane) Huse; his daughter, Charlotte J. Huse of Boston; his son, Robert C. Huse and his wife, Catherine, of Lunenburg, his sister, Pamela Storm of Lunenburg, and his grandchildren, Charlie and Anna Huse. He also leaves many sisters-in-law, brothers-in-law, nieces, and

nephews.

A celebration of his life will be held in the spring.
