TOWNSEND/FITCHBURG: Cheralyn R. (Giard) Call, 71, formerly of Townsend and Fitchburg, died Wednesday, November 30, 2022 at Life Care Center of Leominster.

Cheralyn was born in Montague, Massachusetts on January 24, 1951, one of five children born to Norma (Herzig) Giard and the late Raymond Giard, and grew up in Colrain.

Cheralyn graduated from Mohawk Trail Regional High School in Buckland in 1969 and continued her education at Fitchburg State College where she majored in Nursing and later the University of Massachusetts Lowell where she became a Nurse Practitioner.

Cheralyn had worked many years as the school nurse at Mascenic Regional High School in New Ipswich, NH.

Cheralyn was admired by her friends and family for her compassion, her patience and her wisdom and she is described as a sweet, kind, gentle and loving soul. She enjoyed many crafts to include quilting, sewing and scrapbooking. Cheralyn was a devout Catholic and attended St. John's Church in Townsend and later St. Joseph's Church in Fitchburg.
