FITCHBURG: Craig A. Connors, 53, of Fitchburg, formerly of Townsend, died unexpectedly, Wednesday, September 18, 2019 at his home.

Craig was born in Fitchburg, April 30, 1966, a son of Lynne T. (Sheedy) Connors and the late Kenneth D. Connors and resided many years in Townsend before moving to Fitchburg fifteen years ago. He was a 1984 graduate of North Middlesex Regional High School in Townsend and later attended Quinsigamond Community College and Becker College, both in Worcester.
