



## Daniel H. Taylor Jr.

April 28, 1935 - August 26, 2025

SHIRLEY: Daniel H. Taylor, Jr., 90, of Shirley, died Tuesday, August 26, 2025 at Ayer Valley Nursing & Rehabilitation Center, Ayer.

His wife of 64 years, Janet E. (Hull) Taylor, died in December 2020.

Daniel was born in Providence, RI, April 28, 1935 a son of Daniel H. and Gertrude (Larson) Taylor and grew up in Providence.

Following his graduation from high school in 1953, Daniel enlisted in the United States Army. He proudly served his country for over 20 years and was awarded many commendations including the Meritorious Service Medal, Legion of Merit Medal and the Army Commendation Medal.

Following his retirement from the armed services in 1973, Daniel continued to serve his country for fifteen years as a civil servant at Fort Devens. Following his retirement, he and his wife enjoyed spending winters in the Bradenton, Florida area.

He was a Mason for 66 years and a proud member of the Caleb Butler Lodge AF & AM in Ayer as well as the Aleppo Lodge of Shriners.

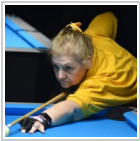
