PORT ST. LUCIE, FL/ SHIRLEY: Donald A. "Pe" Lambert, 90, of Port St. Lucie, Florida, formerly of Shirley, died Wednesday, April 20, 2022.

Don is survived by two sons, Donald A. Lambert, Jr and his wife Lynn of Port St. Lucie, FL, and Mike Lambert and his wife Christine of Miramar, FL; two sisters, Dorothy Esposito of Cocoa Beach, FL, and Sylvia A. Callahan of Leominster. Anthony's Cemetery.
