Mr. Keefe was born in Townsend, August 13, 1927, a son of Cornelius P. and Esther (Bagley) Keefe and was a lifelong Townsend resident. He attended Townsend High School and in 1950 graduated from Fitchburg State College. Following his graduation from high school, Mr. Keefe served his country in the United States Army Air Corps.

For 35 years Mr. Keefe taught math and science at the North Middlesex Regional High School in Townsend, retiring in 1987.

He leaves a brother, Kenneth D. Keefe of South Pasadena, FL; several nieces and nephews including, Michael Keefe of Townsend, Linda Amadon and her husband, Bill, of New Ipswich, NH, , Mark Smith and his wife, Debra of Florida Christopher Smith and his wife, Aileen, of Staten Island, NY, Virginia Sheridan and Kenneth Keefe both of Florida. He also leaves several grandnieces and grandnephews.

He was the brother of the late Alden P. Keefe of New Ipswich, NH and Priscilla Smith of Leominster.

An avid traveler, Mr. Keefe visited 46 of the fifty states. An aficionado of fire equipment, he had an extensive collection of fire equipment models and photographs and had been recognized and an "Honorary Fire Fighter" by the Townsend Fire Department. During the 1950's he was instrumental in the

development of the Townsend Little League Program.
