FITCHBURG: Donald A. Laramée, 49, of Fitchburg, died unexpectedly Tuesday, June 15, 2021 at St. Luke's Hospital, New Bedford. Don was a registered organ donor and as a result aided three other individuals through his bequest.

Don was born in Fitchburg, July 5, 1971, one of seven children born to the late John and Patricia (Machunsky) Laramée and was a lifelong Fitchburg resident. He was a 1989 graduate of Montachusett Regional Technical High School where his focus of study was Carpentry.
