Dorina P. (Maillet) “Pam” Boucher: A Life Defined by Love and Kindness.

Dorina P. (Maillet) “Pam” Boucher, a cherished mother, devoted wife and grandmother, passed away peacefully on Tuesday evening, October 28, 2025, at the age of 93. She died surrounded by the love of her family at her home in Fitchburg.

Born on July 17, 1932, in Fitchburg to the late Eugene and Edna (Robichaud) Maillet, Pam inherited a spirit of resilience and a remarkable capacity for joy, kindness and compassion. She attended Fitchburg schools and was a lifelong resident of the city and a longtime member of St. Joseph’s Parish.

She married her beloved husband, Aldege J. Boucher, who predeceased her earlier this year in February after seventy years of marriage. She will be profoundly missed by her daughter, Michelle, and son-in-law, Matthew; her brother, Denis Maillet of Ware; her two loving grandchildren, Tanner and Kendall Cote; her one month old great-granddaughter, Sylvie who she was able to meet and cuddle prior to her passing; her bonus grandson Camren Beauvais; and several nieces and nephews.
