In her later years, she enjoyed the quieter activities of her wordsearch puzzles and spending time

with family. During her short, final stay at LifeCare Center, she was able to enjoy Bingo, Ice Cream Socials and Music events thanks to help of the kind staff. Although she lived a long and good life, her quick wit and kindness will be missed by all who knew her.

She leaves her daughter, Renee Gaitan of Fitchburg; her sister, Theresa Fortier of Fitchburg; her daughter in law, Maryann LaPointe of Leominster; three grandchildren, Audrey Gaitan, Michelle L.
