May 19, 1918 - October 8, 2018

Townsend: Dorothy C. (Daniels) Manceau, 100, of Townsend died Monday, October 8, 2018 at Health Alliance – Leominster Hospital after a brief illness. She was predeceased by her husband, Ernest J. Manceau, in 1986.

Mrs. Manceau was born in Fitchburg, May 19, 1918 one of ten children born to Treffle "Pete" and Phebe (Auger) Daniels and resided in Townsend for nearly 70 years.
