



Dorothy M. "Dolly" Thompson

July 13, 1941 - July 29, 2024

LUNENBURG: Dorothy M. "Dolly" (Borneman) Thompson, 83, of Leominster and a former longtime resident of the Hickory Hills neighborhood in Lunenburg, passed away on Monday, July 29, 2024 in the Jewish Healthcare Center in Worcester.

Dolly was born in Pepperell, July 13, 1941, one of seven children born to Arthur B. and Ethel M. (Shepherd) Borneman and was a 1960 graduate of Spaulding Memorial High School in Townsend.

For seventeen years, Dolly worked in the cafeteria at Leominster High School before retiring in 2022. Prior to that she had worked at New England Business Service in Townsend and Wachusett Potato Chip Company in Fitchburg.

Dolly was a longtime member of the United Parish, where she sang in the choir. She also enjoyed her weekly visits with Greg and taking car rides with Barbara up the coast of New Hampshire.

She leaves two daughters, Nancy Thompson of Charlton, Sharon Griffin of Milbury; her son, Gregory Thompson of Hubbardston; two sisters, Barbara Borneman of Leominster and Joyce Hicks of Rome, NY. She also leaves her granddaughter, Olivia Griffin of Uxbridge and several nieces and nephews and her beloved granddog, "Bixby".

She was the sister of the late Wallace Borneman of Fitchburg, Richard Borneman, Eleanor Lauze and Arthur "Buster" Borneman all of Townsend. In addition, she was predeceased by her former husband, Normand J. Thompson

Funeral services will be held Tuesday, August 6, at 11AM in the United Parish, Main Street, Lunenburg. Interment will follow at North Cemetery, Lunenburg.
