Lunenburg- Edward A. O'Brien, 76, of Leominster formerly of Lunenburg passed away on Tuesday, February 13, 2024 in the Health Alliance Leominster Hospital.

Ed was born in Brooklyn, NY, on February 5, 1948, to the late Patrick J. and Marjorie (Rochford) O'Brien. and grew up in Attleboro. The youngest of four brothers, known as the "Four Shamrocks," he graduated from Msgr. James Coyle High School in Taunton in 1966.
