



## Ernest B. LeCuyer

December 19, 1931 - January 19, 2024

LUNENBURG: Ernest B. LeCuyer, 92, of Winchendon, formerly of Townsend and Lunenburg died Friday, January 19, 2024 at his residence.

Mr. LeCuyer was born in Fitchburg, December 19, 1931, one of five children born to Ralph G. and Celeste (Richard) LeCuyer and attended Spaulding Memorial School in Townsend. He resided in Lunenburg for over 60 years before moving to Winchendon 7 years ago.

For approximately 40 years, Mr. LeCuyer owned and operated the Ernest B. LeCuyer Construction Company before retiring in 1994. Prior to that he had worked at the Fessenden Barrell Company in Townsend and General Electric Company in Fitchburg. He had also served as an Auxiliary Policeman in the Lunenburg Police Department.

He was a member of the Aurora Lodge A.F. & A.M., Charles W. Moore Lodge of Masons, Aleppo Temple Shrine and the Knight Templar Shriners. He was a former member of the Lunenburg Sportsman's Club and the Eastwood Club in Fitchburg. He had attended St. Boniface Church in Lunenburg and St. John's Church in Townsend.

He leaves four sons, James E. LeCuyer and his wife, Anne, of Townsend, Randal J. LeCuyer and his wife, Susan of Phillipston, Rick A. LeCuyer and his

companion, Deanne Castine of Townsend, and Dana F. LeCuyer and his wife, Jeanne, of Townsend; two brothers, Bernard LeCuyer of Lunenburg, Ralph LeCuyer of Townsend; two sisters, Dorothy Valcourt of Leominster, Rachel Martin of Tennessee; his companion of thirteen years, Jeannine Murphy of Winchendon; seven grandchildren, Ryan LeCuyer, Katherine Santangelo, Marie Bacchus, Aaron LeCuyer, Justin LeCuyer, Jacqueline LeCuyer, Elisa Roberts and Twelve great grandchildren, Lorelai Santangelo, Raymond LeCuyer, Camden Santangelo, Natasha-Elisabeth, Alexandra-Marie, Ayla LeCuyer, Rosie LeCuyer, Blake LeCuyer, Daisy Bacchus, Evan Roberts, Kensley Roberts, and Waylon Roberts.

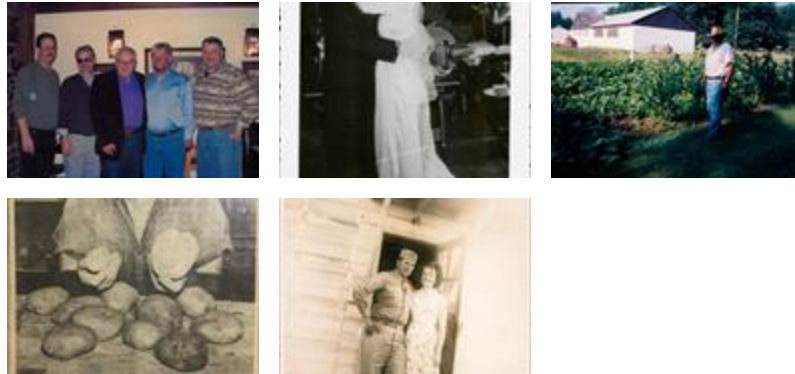
