



Eugene A. "Buddy" Wyson

Eugene "Buddy" Wyson from Lunenburg, MA passed away suddenly surrounded by family in the early morning hours of February 21, 2024. Bud was 85 years old. He is preceded by his mother Ina Liikanen, his father Alexander Wyson, and his brother Barry L. Wyson. He is survived by his wife, Mary Ann Wyson, and his three children Keith, Kimberly, and Kristopher.

Buddy lived a life full enough to fill twenty. He was a sailor in the United States Navy on the U.S.S. Plymouth Rock LSD-29 beginning in 1958 and attained the rank of MM3, Machinist's Mate, before honorably finishing his service in 1962. Also a mathematics teacher at Leominster High School, Buddy just as well taught humility, patience, and compassion to all of those blessed to know him.

Buddy was a leading expert in 1950's Ford trucks and felt the most at home spending time with his six grandchildren who he gave a world of love.
