TOWNSEND- Floyd L Truitt, 88, of Townsend, Died Sunday, June 30, 2019 in the Apple Valley Center in Ayer.

Floyd was born in Ridley Park, Pa. on October 26, 1930, a son of the late Willie E. and Elsi May (Newell) Truitt and has resided in Townsend for over sixty years.

He was a Korean Conflict Veteran having served as a corporal in the U.S. Army. Shortly after his honorable discharge from the service, Floyd went to work as an audio visual specialist at Ft. Devens, retiring after 30 years, in 1987.

He was a member of the Townsend Congregational Church. He enjoyed woodworking, photography, visiting Mystic, Ct., covered bridges and travelling throughout New England.
