ASHBURNHAM: Frank Tagliavia, 66, of Ashburnham, formerly of Fitchburg, died unexpectedly Sunday, November 10, 2019.

Frank was born in Fitchburg, September 17, 1953, a son of the late Frank H. and Claire M. (Penzabene) Tagliavia and was a 1971 graduate of Fitchburg High School. He has resided in Ashburnham for over forty years.

For the past ten years Frank has worked as a lab technician at Alpha Gary Corporation in Leominster. Prior to that he had worked at H&V Company in West Groton and at James River Paper Company in Fitchburg.

An avid outdoorsman, Frank enjoyed fishing, hunting, kayaking, snow plowing and especially riding his motorcycle. While at James River he served as a union steward and while at H&V he served on the safety committee.

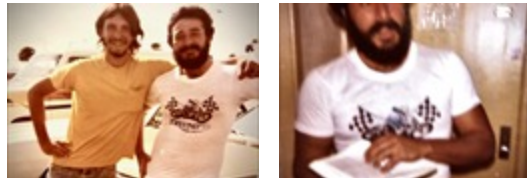
