Ashburnham-Glenn Bishop, 100, of Ashburnham passed away peacefully, on Saturday morning March 8, 2025 in his beloved home on the lake.

Glenn was born in Whitesboro, Texas on August 12, 1924, a son of the late Hustin and Opal (Sullivan) Bishop, and grew up in Texas before joining the United States Navy, where he served his country honorably during World War II.

Following his discharge from the service, Glenn relocated to the northeast settling in Ashburnham and going to work as a manager in the parts department at R & P Parts Rebuilders. He later worked at the Fitchburg Intermodal Transportation Center for several years prior to his retirement.

Glenn loved living on the lake and spending time outdoors doing yardwork and gardening. He also enjoyed boating, country western music and the rodeo. He was an avid fan of the Dallas Cowboys.
