September 1, 1929 - February 22, 2025

FITCHBURG – Gloria (Duguay) Page, 95, passed away peacefully on February 22, 2025, at The Highlands in Fitchburg. Gloria was born in Fitchburg on September 1, 1929, the daughter of Edmund Duguay and Emilie (Leger) Duguay. She was a graduate of Fitchburg High School, class of 1947. In 1948, she married Leo Page, and they built a home in Lunenburg where they raised two sons. Leo died in May 1974.

Throughout her life, Gloria was active in the community, working in local retail stores and participating in several social organizations. She enjoyed spending time with family and friends and maintained a strong connection with her large extended family in Cap-Pelé, New Brunswick, visiting every summer. She was a lifetime lover of dancing including ballroom, country, and line dancing. At the age of 80 she earned Gold Medal Awards in Waltz and East Coast Swing with Honors in Cha Cha at the New England Country Dance Festival. She also enjoyed bowling and playing bingo and cribbage. She was a great baker, known especially for her cookies and cakes. She enjoyed her involvement with the Lunenburg Friendly Seniors Group at the Eagle House Senior Center and was a member of St. Boniface Church.

Gloria's companion of 28 years, Emile LeBlanc, died in January 2004. She is survived by two sons and a daughter-in-law, Robert Page of Boston and Michael and Martha Page of Winchendon; a stepson and daughter-in-law,

Cary and Diane LeBlanc of Princeton; four grandchildren, Michael Page, Matthew Page (Jess), Sarah Shaw (Dan), and Alexander LeBlanc (Ashley); five great grandchildren, Ada, Warren, Grady, Avery, and Paxton; and many cousins in Cap-Pelé, New Brunswick.
