ASHBY: Guillermo E. "G" Morales, 39, of Ashby, died unexpectedly Monday, May 25, 2026 at Health Alliance - Leominster Hospital.

G was born in San Salvador, El Salvador, June 20, 1986 a son of Guillermo and Alessandra Osorio and was a graduate of Revere High School. Following his graduation from high school, G enlisted and served eight years in the United States Marine Corps. While serving his country G was assigned to two tours in the Middle East, participating in Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom. He was trained in several areas of counterterrorism and received several meritorious awards and decorations including the Presidential Unit Citation, Navy Unit Commendations and the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal. He was honorably discharged in August 2013 at the rank of Sergeant.

After being discharged, G found a passion in working with dogs in order to train them in the field of security and protection; including French Ring, PSA, and Mondio Ring, and worked different Dog Trials around the United States. He had resided in Fitchburg before moving to Ashby six years ago.

For the past four years, G had worked as a IT Data Center Infrastructure Engineer at MIT Labs in Holyoke/Lexington. Previously, he held similar positions at Masy Bio Services in Pepperell and University of Massachusetts –

Memorial Hospital in Worcester. He very recently obtained his associates and bachelors degrees from SNHU in Information Technologies.

In addition to his parents of Revere, G leaves his wife of seven years, Lauren M. (Pires) Morales; his sons, Cole Stapel, Damian Morales, Mateo Morales all of Ashby; two daughters, Arya Stapel, Amelia Morales also of Ashby; and large extended family spread all over.

G's family will receive relatives and friends at calling hours from 4- 7 PM Tuesday, June 2, 2026 at the Anderson Funeral Home, 250 Main Street (Rte. 119) Townsend Center. A prayer service with military honors will be held 1 PM Wednesday, June 3, 2026 at the chapel of the Massachusetts Veterans Memorial Cemetery, 111 Glenallen Street, Winchendon.
