Hind Jarest Hubbard, 86, formerly Helen B. Jarest, of Townsend, MA, passed away peacefully on April 2, 2026 at Sherrill House in Boston.

Hind was born in Groton, MA on December 24, 1939, daughter of the late Paul and Bertha (Mattila) Jarest. She was predeceased by her husband, Silas Hubbard Jr.

Hind was a dedicated teacher who inspired countless students throughout her career. She was a student as well, earning a Bachelor of Science from Clark University, Master of Education from Northeastern University, and Doctorate of Education from UMASS Amherst, which allowed her to bring innovative real-world approaches to teaching math.

Hind began her career in education at the North Middlesex Regional High School, where she taught before moving to the Plymouth School System, ultimately teaching math at the Grover Cleveland Middle School in Boston until retirement. During the holidays, Hind was a seasonal employee of Neiman Marcus, a time she always looked back on fondly.

Beyond her career, Hind was adventurous. She loved traveling and explored remarkable places in the Middle East, which inspired her to adopt the name Hind. She also enjoyed studying Arabic at Harvard University, the Red Sox,

jazz, and the energy of city life in Boston.

She is survived by her sister Jane Jarest Hemingway; her niece Saana Markova Hemingway and her great-nieces and great-nephew. The family would like to thank the staff at Sherrill House for their compassionate care.
