AYER: Herbert K. Hillman, 58, of Ayer, a longtime Westford resident, died Friday, February 16, 2024 peacefully at his home.

Herb was born in Lowell, April 22, 1965, one of six children born to the late Herbert K. and Carol A. (Leighton) Hillman and resided in Westford until moving to Ayer eight years ago.

He was a graduate of Nashoba Technical High School in Westford where his focus of study was heating, ventilation and air conditioning.

Beginning at an early age, Herb was well-known to be a hard worker and became accomplished in his trades of HVAC as well as remodeling and construction. For several years he owned and operated Herb Hillman Heating in Westford which was later expanded to include larger and more complex construction projects.
