Ayer: Jean F. (McDonald) Diemert, 77, of Ayer, passed away Saturday, January 4, 2025. Jean was born in Providence, RI, the daughter of the late Jacqueline (Ward) and Thomas Way McDonald, and grew up in Pawtucket, RI.

This formidable foursome lived in Acton, MA where they were involved in school and community activities.

Faith was a large part of Jean's life. She was a member of St Mary's Church in Ayer where she taught Faith Formation and was a Eucharistic Minister.

After family, Jean had two lifelong passions. She was a poet, writer and avid reader. Jean was always sharing great reads and was a member in multiple writing groups. Jean felt most at peace in her beloved cottage in Tenants Harbor, ME. She especially loved hosting family and taking long walks along the shore. Her volunteer work aligned as well. She was a volunteer at the

Jackson Memorial Library in Tenants Harbor and at the Marshall Point Lighthouse Museum in Port Clyde, ME.

Jean was a teacher in Lynn MA, Acton MA, Concord MA., first in elementary schools, then as a librarian and special education.
