She would sometimes get caught up in mischief but always showed kindness to those in need. A graduate of Barnstable High School class of 1997, Jenn furthered her education by earning an associate degree from Becker College in veterinary science. In college, her mischievous ways would continue, which is how she first met Kathleen Bragdon, one of the Becker Resident Assistants (RA). In typical Jenn fashion, over time Kathleen became her best friend then as fate would have it, eventually her sister-in-law. Jenn met the love of her life, when

Kathleen's brother Tim was helping her move into her dorm, and he had no idea the whirlwind he was about to experience. She courted him in overalls, footsie pajamas and by introducing him to Bumby. Jenn certainly wasn't a good cook and when holding a baby, if the baby cried, she would cry too and hand it back. But Tim quickly saw something special in Jenn through her smile and joy for life, and they were soon engaged. A Cape wedding couldn't be stopped by hurricane Ivan passing through, but it did change the outdoor wedding she'd always dreamt about into an indoor wedding. Jenn despised the name Ivan ever since. Over the years Jenn became an amazing cook and an even more incredible mother. She had a special connection with each of her children and instinctively knew how each needed a different type of "mumma" as she was affectionately called; her morning routine with Luke before everyone else got up, watching shows and chatting with Ellie or singing Karaoke with Logan.

She "fostered" (prelude to adopting) pets that were in poor health and were often considered unadoptable. These animals would become part of her family and would be loved and cherished in a way only she could. Jenn was deeply committed to her community and volunteered with TheraPaws; an organization dedicated to providing therapeutic animal visits at local schools. Her involvement with TheraPaws was a testament to her compassionate nature and her desire to bring comfort and joy to others. Her passion for helping those in need was evident throughout her life and she instilled these values in her children.

Jenn is survived by her loving husband, Timothy Sinclair Bragdon, their three children, Lucas, Ellaina, and Logan, her mother, and her maternal grandmother. Her love for her family was boundless, and she was a constant source of strength and encouragement for them. She was the foundation of the family and always found ways to make every occasion special and

memorable. Jenn's nurturing spirit extended beyond her immediate family, as she was known for her kindness and willingness to help others in their time of need.

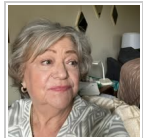
