SHIRLEY – John O. Brackett, 81, passed away peacefully on May 7, 2023 in Nashoba Hospital.

John was born in Rangeley, ME on January 17, 1942, a son of the late Edgar and Helen (Gray) Brackett.

He graduated from Rangeley High School and shortly after, traveled to try out for the Red Sox. John enlisted in the US Marine Corps in 1960, where he proudly served his country during the Vietnam War. Once discharged in 1963, he went to work for the Sampson Rope Factory in Shirley. In 1971 John enlisted in the Army National Guard, a career that spanned 25 years; retiring in 1997 as a Supply Sergeant with several medals and decorations.

John enjoyed playing bocce and horseshoes. He also loved to play golf and spend time with his family.

He is survived by his two sons, David and Scott Brackett; a grandson, Andrew; siblings, Jake, Randy, Becky, Jenny, Grace, and Diane; many nieces and nephews.

John was predeceased by his loving wife Linda (Carignan) Brackett on May 16, 2020 and his brother Moochey Brackett.
