LUNENBURG: John Francis Lattanzi was born to John and Frances (Lynch) Lattanzi on April 1, 1936, in Yonkers, New York. He grew up in Yonkers and Washington, New Jersey. In his youth John developed a life-long affinity for mischief, playing rousing piano by ear, and a love of outdoor pursuits. He graduated from Lafayette College in 1958, served as an officer in the U.S. Army, then embarked on a 30-year career with the American Can Company.

He met his life-long partner, Christine Uhl, in 1961. They married, purchased a camp on Sebec Lake in Maine and started their family soon after. John and Christine raised their family in Cranford, NJ and Geneva, NY before moving to Lunenburg, MA in 1982.

Over the past 43 years, John served his community in various roles on the Lunenburg Personnel Board, Conservation Commission, and Historical Society. John was a member of Saint Boniface and Our Lady of the Lake Churches, the Lunenburg Sportsman Club and the Sebec Lake Association.

John leaves behind his beloved wife of over 61 years, and their five children; John Lattanzi Jr. and his wife Karen of Honolulu, HI; Jean Proctor and husband Dan of Lunenburg, MA; Peter Lattanzi and wife Dina of Cumberland, ME; Paul Lattanzi and wife AnnMarie of Yarmouth, ME; and James Lattanzi and wife Allison of Fitchburg, MA. John also leaves behind 15 grandchildren

and his younger sister, Jane O'Connell, of Durham, NH.

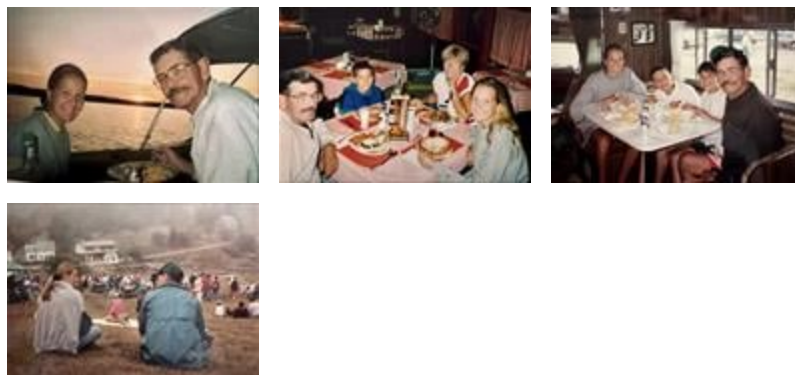
