Mr. Martin was born in Brockton, November 5, 1950, a son of the late Joseph and Mary (Spadea) Martin and grew up in Avon. He was a 1968 graduate of Avon High School and continued his education at the University of Lowell and Northeastern University where he majored in Engineering and Computer Science.

During the Vietnam era, Mr. Martin served his country in the United States Coast Guard. He enjoyed fly fishing and operated his ham radio under the name "WA1ETC"
