AYER: John D. Wright, 55, of Ayer, died unexpectedly Tuesday, January 19, 2021, at his home.

John was born at the Fort Devens Hospital in Shirley Massachusetts on September 4, 1965. He was the youngest of nine children born to the late Bennie H. and Mary D. (Lane) Wright and resided much of his life in Ayer. He was a 1983 graduate of Ayer High School and continued his education at Emerson College in Boston.

John moved to Reno Nevada and worked in the Hospitality and Resort industry for about 20 years before returning to Ayer to live with and care for his Mother.

John held the position of Director of Operations at the Marriott Hotel in Cambridge for Highgate Hotels. He was an avid Boston Sports fan, especially the New England Patriots. He loved dancing and music, especially Stevie Nicks songs.

He attended New Patriots Christian Congregation Church in Fitchburg.

He leaves two brothers, Bennie (Marilyn) Wright and Michael Wright both of Virginia; five sisters, Melva Morin of Leominster, Linda (Charles) Fuller of

Maryland, Marsha Murdaugh of Nashua, NH, Queida (Raymond) Davis of Ayer, and Carol Wright of Lunenburg.

He was the brother of the late Kenneth (Carlotta), Wright of Leominster. John also leaves a host of Nieces, Nephews, and Cousins.

John's family will receive family and friends at calling hours on Friday, January 29, 2021, from 4-7 PM at the Anderson Funeral Home, 25 Fitchburg Rd. (Rte 2A) Ayer.
