LEOMINSTER: Joseph A. Duval, Jr., 78, formerly of Greenville, NH, and Fitchburg, MA, peacefully passed away on Thursday, December 25, 2025, at Leominster Rehabilitation and Nursing Home.

Born in Peterborough, New Hampshire, on August 3, 1947, Joseph was the son of Joseph and Mary (Tasca) Duval. After graduating from Appleton Academy, he enlisted in the United States Army, serving honorably during the Vietnam era.

Joseph was a longtime member of Sacred Heart Church and the Knights of Columbus in Greenville, NH. For over 30 years, he proudly served as president of Greenville Hardware, working side by side with his beloved wife, Beverly, who held the title of vice-president.
