AYER: Josephine M. "Phine" (McGuane) Wallace, 90, a long-time Ayer resident died March 21, 2023, at her home.

Her husband of 67 years, Donald R. Wallace, died this past February 4th.

Phine was born in Ayer, on February 9, 1933, the daughter of Paul K. and Mary C. (Horgan) McGuane, and was a 1951 graduate of Notre Dame Academy in Tyngsboro.

Phine's work career included several and varied positions including a van driver for Dee Bus in Shirley, office personnel at the Groton School in Groton, lunch lady at Notre Dame Academy in Tyngsboro, and telephone operator for New England Telephone.

She was a lifelong member of St. Mary's Parish in Ayer and was a member of its Catholic Daughters of America and Catholic Youth Organization. She also was a member of the Pleasant Street School Preservation Committee.
