SHIRLEY: Joyce M. (Lippiatt) Calabrese Patton, 87, of Shirley, formerly of Townsend, died Tuesday, February 18, 2025 at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, Boston.

Joyce was born in Washingtonville, Ohio, October 29, 1937 a daughter of Robert J. and Lillian R. (Needham) Lippiatt and resided in Townsend before moving to Shirley twenty years ago.

She attended the Washingtonville (Ohio) elementary and middle schools before graduating from the Leetonia High School in 1955.

For nearly 25 years, Joyce worked as an executive administrative assistant at New England Business and later Deluxe Company before retiring in 2004. Previously, she had worked in a similar capacity at North Middlesex Regional High School in Townsend, National Rubber Machinery Company in Columbiana, Ohio, Thomas Steel Strip Company in Warren Ohio, and Deming Pump Company in Salem, Ohio.

Joyce was an active member of the Shirley Senior Center, Shirley Council on Aging and the Shirley Senior Citizens.
