February 9, 1952 - April 17, 2025

AYER-Juanda M. (Hicks) Sloan, 73, of Ayer, Massachusetts passed away on Thursday morning, April 17, 2025 in the River Terrace Healthcare Center in Lancaster, MA.

Juanda was born on February 9, 1952 in Boston, the daughter of the late Elliot Hicks and Helen Wilson. She is predeceased by her brother Donald Robertson and leaves to mourn her passing, her sisters, Carol Huckaby of Hamden, CT, and Yvonne Gailliard of Ayer MA and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

Juanda's early childhood was spent in Boston and then 3 years in Baumholder Germany. In 1964 the family returned to Massachusetts and settled in Ayer, where she graduated from Ayer High School in 1970. During a pastoral visit in 2001 with Pastor Gary Palmer, Juanda prayed to receive Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. She started her career in banking before going to work at Digital Equipment Corporation, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and she retired from Job Corps in Devens. Juanda was instrumental in mentoring at risk youth while working at Job Corps.

Juanda was a loving and kind person a woman of God who loved people and was always willing to listen and help those in need. People appreciated her acceptance of others, enthusiasm, positive attitude, sense of humor and

honesty. In her free time, Juanda enjoyed reading, traveling, watching football, spending time with family and friends, and visiting the beach.

Her funeral service will be held on Saturday, April 26 at 11 AM in the New Hope Community Church, 139 Sandy Pond Rd. Ayer. Burial at a later date will be in the Woodlawn Cemetery in Ayer.
