LUNENBURG- Karen M. (Thibodeau) Ullo, 64, of Lunenburg, entered into the loving arms of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ on Wednesday, August 22, 2018, after a long, courageous battle with breast cancer. She was surrounded by her family at her Mother's home in Fitchburg.

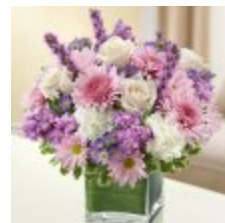

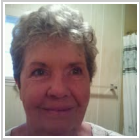
