



## Kenneth S. Tibbetts, of Mason, NH

Mason, NH – Kenneth S. Tibbetts, 80, of Mason, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, May 15, 2026, at St. Joseph Hospital in Nashua, New Hampshire.

Ken enjoyed many hobbies, including hunting, fishing, and coin collecting. He also loved movies, enjoyed a good cup of coffee, and appreciated sharing a great meal with friends. He and his wife spent many evenings with friends, enjoying laughter and playing "Cahds" (cards). Together they enjoyed traveling and trying new experiences. They especially cherished their many trips to Gloucester, reminiscing about the summers they spent there during their childhoods. Ken was known for his storytelling, like any good Scotsman, and for the past 30-plus years looked forward to celebrating at the annual New Hampshire Highland Games.

His loving wife, Judith A. (Koch) Tibbetts of Mason, New Hampshire, passed away on March 6, 2026. He leaves his son, Scott Tibbetts of Mason, New Hampshire; three daughters, Kelli Fitzgerald of Pepperell, Massachusetts, and Kristen Tibbetts and Kourtney Tibbetts, both of Mason, New Hampshire; his brothers, Ralph F.
