TOWNSEND: Kevin C. Ovaska, 65, of Townsend, died Sunday, January 24, 2021 at University of Massachusetts – Memorial Hospital, Worcester after a period of declining health.

Kevin was born in Leominster, April 22, 1955 a son of Eunice (Howard) Tremblay and the late John T. Ovaska Sr. and was a lifelong Townsend resident. He was a 1973 graduate of North Middlesex Regional High School in Townsend.
